The Heart of the Matter



But this is the one to whom I look: he who is humble and contrite in spirit and trembles at my word. -Isaiah 66:2

As we consider the most interesting people in Scripture, Peter has got to be near the top of anybody's list. We can empathize with him, villainize him, feel bad for him, and want to be like him, all within a matter of a few chapters!

My favorite account of Peter is Matthew's account of Jesus' walking on the water. Interestingly, Mark's account of the same event, which draws heavily on Peter's eye-witness input, does NOT include Peter's amazing steps on the water. As impactful as that experience must have been for Peter, I wonder if Jesus' immediate

reaction left a greater impression on Peter than the actual act of walking on the water. Right after Jesus rescued Peter from sinking, Jesus says, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" (Matt. 14:31). For the disciples, Peter's willingness to step out of the boat must have seemed courageous, yet Jesus simply says, "Why didn't you trust me more?"!




When Jesus promised his disciples, in John 14:12, that they would do even greater works than He, we can be assured that this was not limited to walking on water, physical healing, demonic extraction, etc. Since He is most interested in our

maturity in Christ and our walking by faith, not by sight, we must not limit God's blessings to our health, our financial security, or "how well things are going." Indeed, God's biggest blessings are much more significant and long-lasting than what meets the eye: deny yourself daily to follow Jesus, prioritize a humble and contrite heart, consider others as more important than yourself, use your gift to benefit the church . . . You get the idea.*

This can help us better define victory over sin in our lives, don't you think? We certainly ought to be overjoyed and give God glory for 2-week, 2-month, or 2-years of porn sobriety or for victory over other sinful habits. But we also know

the greater work is as we are offering our righteousness (Rom. cross and denying our deepest core



happening in our hearts physical bodies to 6:13), daily taking up our self (Luke 9:23), and at putting to death what is

earthly in us (Col. 3:5). As we enter 2024, may our hope in the battle not depend on how far we've come (or not come) in battling lust and pride. Rather, our hope is in the victory that Jesus has already won, for the new person that He's molding and shaping, for the undeniable, eternal truth that His grace is sufficient for each of us. May God bless you richly as you step out of the boat yourself in 2024!
